

HOW TO LOG-IN TO ELECTRONIC RESOURCES FROM OFF-CAMPUS



EBSCO Databases (off campus):

- 1) Get the username and password you need to access these databases from the library (at **631-423-0483 x141** or via email at libraryweb@icseminary.edu).
- 2) Click on the **Online Resources** link on the side menu of the library page.
- 3) Find and click on “**EBSCO databases**” in the pull-down menu.
- 4) Once on the ONLINE RESOURCES page, click on the [EBSCO databases](#) link there.
- 5) You will now be going in through a proxy server, courtesy of St. Joseph’s Seminary. The page is very “bare-bones.” Find the Login fields, in the top left corner of the page.

TIP: This would be a good time to “bookmark” the site (save it to “favorites”) in your browser, so you can eliminate some of these steps next time.




