The Seminary of the Immaculate Conception began its mission of preparing men for priesthood in 1930. Since that time, more than 1700 priests have been ordained for the Dioceses of Brooklyn and Rockville Centre and the Eastern Province of the Congregation of the Mission (Vincentians). More recently, men arrived from diverse areas outside the United States to study for eventual ordination to priesthood in their home dioceses. These priests have all made and continue to make significant contributions to the life of the Church in distant lands as well as throughout the United States.

Although our seminarians now study at St. Joseph's Seminary in Yonkers, New York, the Seminary remains a vibrant home for the education and formation of permanent deacons for the Diocese of Rockville Centre, as well as those lay students wishing to pursue advanced studies in theology. The Sacred Heart Institute, which is headquartered here, assures continuing education for ordained priests and permanent deacons.

The beauty and tranquility of the Seminary building and grounds offer an ideal setting for retreats, days of recollection, workshops and conferences. Many religious and lay groups utilize the facilities for these purposes.
